


WHAT IS A D-HOOK?



**Where to buy it
and how to use it**



THE BEST PLACE TO BUY D-HOOKS IS BUNNINGS WAREHOUSE

But they can be found in 'Picture Hanging Sets' from other shops like Mitre 10, Spotlight and Amazon.



D-HOOKS ARE ALSO CALLED:

'D-rings' or 'Framing Picture Triangles'

AND OFTEN COME IN PICTURE HANGING KITS



HOW TO INSTALL a D-hook



STEP 1

Measure the **HEIGHT** of the canvas or frame.

Divide this measurement by three.



STEP 2


Mark a third of the height from the **TOP** of the canvas.

e.g: if the canvas is 36cm long, then a third of the length is 12cm. Then measure from the top 12cm down.




STEP 3

Using an adequate sized D-hook, place the hole of the D-hook over the drawn mark.



STEP 4

CAREFULLY (using an electric or hand screwdriver) drill the screw and D-hook into the canvas over the drawn mark.





STEP 5

Ensure that both D-hook triangles are facing up, and that they are screwed tight enough that they do not move/spin around.



STEP 6

Using framing wire (which comes in 'picture hanging kits') measure out the **WIDTH** of the canvas. Then add on a few inches.




STEP 7

CAREFULLY cut the desired length of wire with pliers.


STEP 8

Thread the wire through the D-hook, then wrap the excess wire back around to secure it.



When repeating this step on the other side, ensure that the wire is tightened to avoid any excess 'slack'.
