## **Art Prize Terms and Conditions:**

- 1. Artists may enter a maximum of 2 works
- 2. Work size must not exceed 1m in any direction and must be able to be lifted by one person.
- 3. Exhibits must be ready to display/hang. Use D hooks and framing wire or cord. Stretch canvases welcome. (do not use single strand brass wire, loose staples, wool or fishing line). Each work must be clearly labelled with Artist's name, Address, Title of Work, Selling Price (optional) and Phone number.
- 4. Any works that are a set/group are regarded as one entry and must be sold as a group.
- 5. Works for sale will attract a 28% commission to the Society.
- 6. Work/s must be received between 10am 1pm on Sunday 25th August or earlier by prior arrangement.
- 7. Work/s must be collected on Saturday 14th or Sunday 15th September between 10 3pm. After 3 months, uncollected works become the property of the Bribie Island Community Arts Society and may be offered for sale.
- 8. EXHIBITORS ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY FOR FREIGHT AND OTHER CHARGES INCURRED IN THE DELIVERY OR RETURN OF AN ENTRY.
- All entries complying with Entry Conditions will be judged but may not be displayed. There will be no refunds for work not hung.
- 10. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 11. While all care is taken, exhibitors are reminded that BICAS does not take responsibility for loss or damage of works. Insurance of work is the artist's responsibility.
- 12. Publicity will be arranged for the Next Generation Art Exhibition and all artists consent to reproductions of their work being used for these purposes.
- 13. Please carefully check details on entry form as no changes will be made to details after closing date.
- 14. We welcome all forms of creative expression in the visual arts. ANY SUBJECT AND ANY MEDIUM.
